Within Activity 3.6 – a Digital Learning Platform and training contents have been developed using the Moodle LMS. Through structured and customized training paths, this platform provides tools and resources to overcome the challenges of internationalization at multiple levels:

Micro-level: Empowering teachers, trainers, and learners with international competences.

Meso-level: Supporting VET providers in building and implementing internationalization strategies.

Macro-level: Guiding regional development agencies and regions in integrating trainers, VET internationalization into territorial innovation systems.

The platform offers comprehensive **tailored training pathways** designed to enhance the competences of three specific groups, addressing the unique challenges they face in an evolving global landscape:

Teachers and Trainers

European Citizenship & Working Across Borders
Students Awareness of Intercultural Diversity

VET Managers

Leadership of VET and Technical HE institutions for internationalization
Creating impact from European collaboration projects

Regional Officers

Creating impact for the internationalization of territories
Supporting effective internationalization policies in VET

The content has been developed using H5P being, each pathway, structured in modules and units. Each module including several topics, while a unit covers a specific topic and has associated a self-assessment quiz. The completion time of each unit may vary from 10 to 50 minutes. In addition to that, each pathway has a digital library containing additional reading. After completing the activities, the user can obtain a DIG.INT Digital Certificate.

Within Activity A3.6, the platform and contents, have been piloted by more than 150 users from partner countries, some of them proving valuable feedback through the online evaluation questionnaire embedded within each pathway.
